



# Camper Equipment List

(enough for one week, laundry is available)

\*\*Camper's can drop off laundry at \$7.00 per 8 lb. load

\*Available at SJ Canteen (SJ raincoats can be pre-ordered)

- o Pillow & 2 Pillow Cases
- o Sheets - 1 flat and 1 fitted (cot or twin size)  
A queen-size fitted will also wrap around the mattress.
- o Optional Mattress pad (foam or quilted fabric)
- o Warm blanket
- o Sleeping bag with optional lightweight liner  
(can be a sheet sewn to make a bag)
- o 2 Bath Towels & Washcloth or Puff
- o 1 Jacket
- o 1 Sweatshirt\* & 1 Sweatpants\*
- o 5 T- Shirts\* (Optional - Please bring one in each color: **red**, **blue**, & yellow/gold for Color Games & **pink** for Pink Wednesday's) **Sleeveless shirts are not allowed for riding.**
- o Optional -1 **Black** t-shirt and 1 **Black** pair of shorts for theater/skit activities
- o 1 White T- Shirt for tie-dyeing\*
- o 5 Shorts
- o **5+ Breeches or Long Pants for riding – required**
- o 8 Underwear
- o 8 High Riding Socks & 8 Sneaker Socks
- o 1 Pair Sneakers
- o 1 Pair Rain Shoes or extra pair of sneakers
- o **1 Pair old sneakers for swimming with the horses – required (Not crocs)**
- o **1 Riding helmet SEI approved - required**
- o **1 pair Riding boots (paddock boots best) – required** - condition and waterproof them before bringing
- o **1 Sturdy Raincoat with hood - required**
- o 2 Bathing Suits & 1 or 2 Beach Towels (And clothespins to hang them to dry!)
- o 1 Pair Sandals/Teva's/ Crocs for Showers
- o 1 Bathrobe (optional)
- o 2 Pajamas/sleepwear
- o 2 Laundry bags – light weight to be washed & dried with clothes
- o Plastic Toiletry Caddy with: Toothbrush, Toothpaste, Soap, Shampoo, Conditioner, Comb or Brush, Hair ties\*
- o Clothes for Banquet Night (1 per session)– casual dress or skirt & nice top, or nice short combo
- o 2 Water Bottles\*
- o 1 Flashlight & extra batteries\* (Headlamps are a great choice)
- o Writing materials\* (Envelopes already addressed and with US postage will make sending letters home easier)
- o First Class & Postcard Stamps\*
- o **Non-aerosol Insect Repellent\* - required**
- o **Non-aerosol Sun Screen – required**
- o Mosquito Head Net (for gnats) \*
- o Watch
- o Shoe-box size plastic bin or Tupperware type with tight fitting lid filled with your favorite snacks (try to be nut/peanut-free)

Please try not to bring things which are harmful to the environment e.g. aerosols, disposable flashlight, etc.

**Optional equipment: books, musical instruments, ½ chaps, inexpensive camera, battery powered fan, battery powered lantern, personal protective vest for x-country riding (we have vests available to borrow).**

Please limit baggage to camp trunk (up to 13" high fits under most beds) and one duffel bag or other bag. Trunks are a great investment but are not required. **Please label ALL equipment and clothes with camper's name.** SJ Riding Camp is not responsible for the loss or damage of personal items so please do not bring treasured or expensive items. Personal riding and sports equipment brought to camp must meet the same safety standards and storage requirements as camp-owned equipment.

**Items Not Allowed:** Alcohol, anything that connects to the internet, candles, cell phones, all drugs (prescription and over the counter drugs are to be given to the nurse), lighters & anything fire related, pets, pocketknife, tobacco, or weapons.

We suggest parents pack with their daughter, regardless of age.

LABEL EVERYTHING, including socks! Put a copy of this list in your trunk or duffel.
